MEDIOBANCA SGR BECOMES SIGNATORY TO PRINCIPLES FOR RESPONSIBLE INVESTMENT PROMOTED BY UNITED NATIONS

Milan, 17 September 2019 – **Mediobanca SGR** has become a signatory to the United Nations' Principles for Responsible Investment (UNPRI), the initiative set up to promote a sustainable and responsible approach to investment.

In adhering to the six UNPRI principles, the Mediobanca Group's fund management arm is renewing its commitment to create a more responsible and sustainable finance.

"The decision to become signatories to the Principles for Responsible Investment promoted by the United Nations is consistent with the commitment which the Mediobanca Group has made in its Sustainability Policy to target growth which is sustainable over time, to valorize its staff, show sensitivity to the societies in which we operate, and reduce our direct and indirect impact on the environment", said Emilio Franco, CEO of Mediobanca SGR, who added: "These days the investment process does not dare to leave environmental, social and governance factors out of the analysis, because everyone now agrees these are fundamental to achieving positive and sustainable results over time: for us, our clients, and the societies in which we operate".

Launched in April 2006 at the New York Stock Exchange, the Principles for Responsible Investment initiative has continued to grow, and now has more than 2,300 signatories worldwide, making it the leading global network for responsible investing.
